Veramonte has been controlled by the Gonzalez Byass winery, from Spain, since 2016. One of the leading wineries in Casablanca, the company only uses organic estate-owned grapes from there and Colchagua; Marchigüe and Apalta. Focused on quality terroir driven wines, Primus 2016 and Neyen 2015 are Bordeaux Style reds while Ritual is a Burgundy style Pinot Noir from a warm year.

Made with 40% Cabernet Sauvignon and 35% Carménère, the rest accounted for by Petit Verdot, Merlot, Syrah and Franc in homeopathic doses, all from Apalta. Sweet spices, rose petals and cassis are all present on the nose, along with barrel aromas. Intense and dry with fine, firm tannins, it fills the mouth with a bold flavor.
